- ✓ Time and reading 'o'clock'; When the big hand points to 12 that means o' clock, the shorter hand tells us the hour, we always read the short hand first e.g. 2 o' clock.

- ✓ The concepts of first, next and last.
- ✓ Working on the number line and practicing jumping on and back from a given number.

- ✓ Recap the following 2D shapes: square, circle, semi-circle, rectangle, triangle, star and heart (\*Use the relevant sections of the power point attached).
- ✓ Discuss how many edges, corners each contain. What makes them similar/different?

- ✓ Activity sheet: 2D shape rocket. Name the shapes you see, colour the rocket in.

# Wednesday

- ✓ Design your own pizza using 2D shapes ⊕

## Thursday

**Number formation revision:** Busy at Maths School Workbook-Revise the story of 7; pg.40 (\*see correct number formation\*).

- ✓ Practice writing the number 7- for the number 7 we start at the dot, go across and then down at a slant. Practice writing the number in squares (maths copy) and keep the number formation neat and contained within a space).
- ✓ Practice counting using a counting can; drop stones/marbles into a can one at a time, then ask how many drops/beats did you count?
- ✓ Draw or make sets of 7 using items from around the house.
- ✓ Make 7 in different ways; combine various groups of objects to make
  7 e.g. 4 bowls and 3 bowls make 7 bowls.
